

## COMMISSIONER FOR OATHS APPLICATION

	CHECKLIST	
1. Application Form	Must be in Form 12 (attached)	
2. Two Recent Character References	Must be from 2 <b>different referees</b> from 2 different organizations who have known the applicant for at least 12 months and who are either the <b>holders of a responsible position</b> or have <b>some standing in the community.</b>	
3. National Police Clearance Certificate	Must be <b>original</b> and issued by the <b>National Criminal Records &amp; Intelligence Office</b> of the Royal (PNG) Constabulary Police Headquarters within the last <b>six</b> (6) months	
4. A Recent Letter of Support	Must be from the applicant's employer if the appointment is required for employment duties/purposes and must outline the reason(s) for requiring the appointment; or	
	Must be from the relevant community organisation if the applicant requires the appointment for <b>community involvement</b> purposes	
5. Proof of Identification	Copy of both sides of Drivers Licence (with signature) or Passport or National Identification Card (NID) or Employment ID.  Non-citizens <i>must</i> provide copy of their valid Work Permit & current Passport Bio Data page in addition to either of the above.	[
	An applicant must also submit 2 recent coloured passport-sized photos (with signatures on the back)	
6. Birth Certificate	Must be from the National Civil Registry Office  Applicant must be mature, i.e., the applicant must be 30 years of age and above.  Birth Certificate requirements is <b>not applicable</b> to non-citizens.	
7. Proof of Application Fee Payment	Original Receipt for payment of application fee of K1, 000.00 into the Consolidated Revenue Fund under Attorney General Revenue Sundry Receipts Vote (125.99) at Finance Department, Vulupindi House, or any Treasury Office must be provided  Cash or any personal cheques are NOT acceptable
